# **Zurich proposes Sabine Keller-Busse for election to the Board of Directors**

The proposed election will take place at the Annual General Meeting on April 7, 2021. Due to the current COVID-19 situation, the meeting will be held without the physical attendance of shareholders, who can exercise their voting-rights via the Independent Voting Rights Representative.
